As this newsletter is posted through your door, we are at the start of Easter week, also called Holy Week. I love the way that every year we take time to remember in dramatic detail the

events of this week all those years ago, so we can enter as fully as possible into the Easter story.

We move from the throng of the boisterous crowd to Jesus's lonely walk to death, from the empty tomb and the shocked disciples to the beginnings of something new and unfamiliar. No matter how many times we tell this story, or how often the church proclaims it from the pulpit, it is truly startling. God loves the world so much that he gave his only Son.... The Peter and Paul Centre (PPC), Activate, St Mary with St Alban, St Michael's, St Mark's, Teddington Baptist Church, Teddington Methodist Church, Sacred Heart and the Salvation Army collaborated to ensure there was, and will be, a cosy space, a friendly face and a hot drink and snack for anyone that wanted it, every weekday from All Souls Day to Easter. Thanks to volunteers who gave their time, and Richmond and Wandsworth Council who provided a generous grant, we could offer free drop-in cafes, a weekly lunch and dinner, a school pick-up play space and other community get togethers, as well as hot water bottles. With spring the programme comes to a close. We would

like to thank those who helped out, and those who dropped by.

Many spaces will continue to open, still free but with donations gratefully received. Look out for churches offering cool spaces in the summer too.
