

HEARING GOD'S WORD

READING – Romans 5.1–5, read by a member of the congregation

By entering through faith into what God has always wanted to do for us—set us right with him, make us fit for him—we have it all together with God because of our Master Jesus. THE EUCHARISTIC PRAYER


The Lord be with you; and also with you.
